




## Phillip O. Berry Academy of Technology



## Athletic Eligibility Requirements for Participation for 9th Grade Students

A student who is promoted from the eighth grade to the ninth grade automatically meets the academic requirements for the <u>first semester</u>. In the spring students will need to meet the following requirements:

- Must meet local promotion standards.
- Must have earned a \*2.0 GPA from previous semester (*beginning second semester*).
- Must have passed a \*\*minimum load of work during the previous semester (beginning second semester).
- Must be in attendance at school for at least one-half of the instructional day.
- Shall not participate if he/she becomes 19 years of age on or before August 31 of said school year.

#### **Residency Requirements**

- The parent / legal custodian must present two (2) valid residency documentations to establish a home school. (for high *school athletic eligibility*)
- A court order is required to establish legal custodianship. A letter from a parent or attorney, even if notarized, does not confer custody or guardianship.
- Student-athletes who do not attend their home school on the first day of school in the 9th grade establish a "sports school" at which they are eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics if they meet all other state and local eligibility requirements.
- Tuition paying student-athletes are not eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics in a CMS school.

#### Dragonfly

- This is the online athletic registration that is required of all athletes that want to play a sport. All athletes must have a completed dragonfly account before they will be allowed to participate in athletic workouts.

All communication with coaches is done through SportsYou. Please see below about joining.


#### How do I join SportYou?
