

Guidance on selecting classes for 9th grade

Number of Classes to Select

- You will take a total of <u>8 classes</u> during your freshman year
 - Core Classes (English, Math, Science & Social Studies)
 - Counts for 4 of those 8 typically (exception our the foundation classes, they take up 2 classes)
 - Most core classes are 4X4 (AP classes are A/B Day)
 - Health/PE (Required)
 - Can be either 4X4 OR A/B Day
 - <u>Electives</u> (typically will take 2-3)
 - Make sure you select alternates for your electives
 - The foundation classes take up 1-2 elective spots depending on how many you are in

What classes should I take?

Use the classes you are in this year to guide you for next year.

Standard 8th ELA	Foundations of English I/Honors English I (2 Classes)
Honors 8th ELA	Honors English I (EOG LV 4 or 5)
Standard 8th Math	Foundations of NC Math I/Honors Math I (2 Classes)
NC Math 1	Honors NC Math 2
NC Math 2	Honors NC Math 3
8th Grade Science	Honors Earth/Environmental Science OR Honors Biology (NC Math 1 and Reading EOG LV 5)
8th Grade Social Studies	Honors World History OR AP World History (Reading EOG LV 4 or 5)
Spanish I Part A & B	Spanish II

Structure of Classes at Hough

4x4

A/B

Example

- Meet every day for a semester
- Freshman Core Classes are 4x4 with the exception of AP World (A/B)

Entire Year's Curriculum covered in Two 9 weeks

• Meet every OTHER day for the entire year

If you have 1 A/B Day elective, you need to select a 2nd A/B day elective

- Orchestra A/B
- H/PE A/B
- Spanish II (4x4)
- Honors Microsoft Word (4x4)

Most Freshmen will have a hybrid schedule; some 4x4 Classes and some A/B day classes.
