Students not attending the field trip due to a behavioral violation or for any other reason must still attend school and scholars should expect a normal workload from each subject. Please understand that the bus rates are fixed. Therefore, **students will not receive a refund if they cannot attend for any reason.**

In order for the students to have ample time to explore Educational Days at Carowinds, the buses will need to return after the end of the school day. Therefore, transportation must be provided for each student from Northridge Middle on the evening of the trip. Buses are scheduled to leave no later than 5:30 PM from Carowinds return to school no later than 6:30 PM. In the case of unexpected delays, students will be allowed to call parents to plan accordingly.

CMS Rights and Responsibilities Handbook and Northridge rules will be enforced during this trip. This includes dress code and behavioral guidelines.

The Carowinds Trip will not be rescheduled due to poor weather.

Chaperones may be needed for this trip. If your schedule allows for a fun day at Carowinds with a small group of scholars, let us know of your interest on the permission slip. In addition, chaperones must have clearance as a CMS Volunteer at least two weeks before the trip. Information as to how to obtain this clearance may be found at www.cms.k12.nc.us. Chaperones will be contacted by an 8th grade teacher two weeks prior to the trip to confirm their participation.
