Content Lead Update:

MTSS Update/Curns- With MAP testing being done, the MTSS team is working on placing Tier 2 and Tier 3 students in ELA and Math on Progress Monitoring plans and having them utilize iReady (for ELA) and Dreambox (for Math) to improve skills in standards that they need growth in. In addition, please remember that tutoring is available before and after school to help students work on areas of growth that they need in Math and ELA to help support their success in the classroom.

Science/McCain- Sixth grade is currently in the thermal energy unit. Focusing on heat transfer, conduction, convection and radiation. Seventh grade is on the Earth atmosphere and weather unit focusing on storms and precipitation along fronts and air masses. Eighth grade is starting earth history and evolution units focusing on the geologic time scales and eras.

Social Studies/Cafero- Sixth grade is starting with the ancient Egypt unit. Seventh grade is starting an exploration unit. Eighth grade is starting the American revolution.

ELA/Mateen- **iReady diagnostic tests were given to tier 2 and 3 students in MTSS through ELA classes. Intervention time will be given to those students whose needs are assessed.

6th Grade: Anchor text: *Percy Jackson and the Lightning Thief*. Students are finishing up writing compare and contrast essays where they evaluate the differences in a scene in the movie and novel/

7th Grade: Anchor text: *A Long Walk to Water*. Students are working on compare/contrast essays where students are evaluating how the author used historical facts in the novel.

8th Grade: Anchor text: Summer of the Mariposas. Students just finished the unit 2 end unit. As they begin unit 3, students will writing compare and contrast essays on various subjects around Latin America folklore.

Math/Johnson-Ritchey- 6th Grade - They will wrap up Unit 2 on Ratios next week and are currently focusing on understanding when two ratios are equivalent. Unit 3 will apply this understanding of ratios to working with percentages (ratios out of 100) and unit rates.

6th Grade Honors - Is just diving into Unit 2 which combines some 6th grade and 7th grade geometry standards. In the first part of Unit 2, 6th grade honors students will be focusing on calculating the area of two-dimensional figures and the surface area of three-dimensional prisms. Later, they apply this knowledge to create scale drawings.

7th Grade - Will begin Unit 3 on the Measuring Circles today. They have just finished their work with scale drawings and proportional relationships.

7th Grade Honors - They will wrap up Unit 2 on Rigid Transformations next week. They are currently focusing on looking at angle relationships that are created by lines that have been transformed. The next unit is on Dilations, a non-rigid transformation, that will reinforce students' prior learning regarding proportional relationships, as they explore similar figures. Both these units focus heavily on 8th grade standards.

8th Grade - Is currently finishing Unit 2 on Dilations and Similarity. They are currently working on exploring how dilations of right triangles can be used to find the slope of a line. In Unit 3, students will apply their understanding of slope to explore linear relationships in many forms (graphs, tables, equations, and word problems).
