Read&Write for Google Chrome[™] Troubleshooting

Watch this <u>instructional video</u> or follow these directions to make sure you have access to Read & Write from your CMS Google account:

- Sign to the **Google Chrome browser** on your laptop.
- Click the **Chrome account button** at the top right of the screen and make sure you are logged in with your CMS Chrome account. For example, firstm.last@cms.k12.nc.us instead of a personal or other account.
- Once you do this, follow the directions to "link data" and "turn on sync" for your account.
- Once you are signed into Chrome and your data is linked look for the purple RW puzzle piece appear beside your URL bar in the browser.

More Troubleshooting Tips

- 1) "Collect Highlights" isn't creating a new document.
- 2) My Vocabulary List is <u>coming up blank</u>.
- 3) I don't have access to Read & Write for Google Chrome:
 - a) Wrong Chrome profile/not logged in Chrome extensions are associated with a Chrome user account. Click the Chrome account name tab at the top right of the screen and make sure you are logged into your CMS Chrome account. For example, firstm.last@cms.k12.nc.us instead of a personal or other account



b) Not Installed - Check to make sure Read&Write for Google Chrome was installed from the Chrome Web Store.



- c) <u>Permissions</u> The Read&Write for Google Chrome toolbar will not appear in Google Docs unless permission was accepted by the user. To repair this issue:
 - i) Visit Google Chrome Permissions.
 - ii) Remove access for Read&Write for Google Chrome.



iii) Then click on the web toolbar icon (the purple puzzle piece in the address bar) and grant access to the extension when prompted.
