Final Exam Exemption Policy

- In order to be considered for exam exemption, a student must either have an A for the F1 grade and no more than 3 absences (excused and unexcused) OR a B for the F1 grade with no more than 1 absence (excused or unexcused).
- To be exempt from the 1st semester final exam (non-EOC) all makeup work must be turned in by January 12, 2024 by 11:59 PM. Make-up work may be turned in after the 12th but will not count towards exam exemption.
- Students are still responsible for all new assignments on Tuesday, January 16 and Wednesday, January 17th. Failure to complete these assignments could drop a student's grades and remove exam exemption.
- The final day for any make-up work to be submitted for a grade is 1/19/24.
- The exam exemption does not apply to A/B midterm exams that will take place in January. All A/B students must be present for exams in January.




