
Attention 10th and 11th Grade Parents

Immunizations and Health Assessments

Non compliant letters were sent home this week with any student missing immunizations and/or health assessments. The deadline has been extended to Friday, October 6,2023. Beginning Monday, October 9, 2023, students not up to date with immunizations or health assessments will be excluded from school. As a reminder, all seniors are required to have 2 meningococcal (MCV) vaccines given at ages 11-12 years and the second dose between ages 16-18.
