Attention all Juniors

All rising Seniors are required to have their 2nd Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine by the first day of their senior year. You should have had 1 dose at age 11-12 years old and a second dose after the age of 16. 2 doses are required by N.C. as well as the military, college, and some jobs. Your best resource for having this done is by your primary care M.D., or at the Mecklenburg County Health Department. Contact Nurse Beth for any questions.

What can you do to help your teens' attendance?

- Notice and support your teen if they are showing signs of anxiety or mental health concerns.


