# **Testing Announcements**

#### **Attention 10th and 11th Grade Parents**

On Wednesday, October 12th, 2022 all 10th and 11th grade students will take the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT) during the school day. This test prepares students to take the SAT and is also the qualifying test for many scholarship programs including the National Merit Scholarship Program. It provides parents, students and teachers valuable data on how well the students can perform in an Advanced Placement course through the use of AP Potential. It also shows the strengths and areas of growth for each student as they prepare to take the SAT and ACT tests for college admission.

- Students who are taking the PSAT should have two No. 2 pencils as they cannot use a mechanical pencil per the College Board.
- If they wish to have a calculator on the Mathematics Calculator allowed test, then they need to bring one with them. A calculator is not required but is allowed.
- Cell phones, Smart watches/phones, Fit Bits, and Bluetooth connected devices are not allowed in the testing rooms.
- Students must arrive to school on time.

# **Nurse's Corner**

#### **Immunizations and Health Assessments**

Immunizations and health assessments are **due by September 29**<sup>th</sup>.

During the first week of school, if your student was missing immunizations or a health assessment, a letter was sent home with details. This is mandated by the State of N.C. requiring that all immunizations be up to date by the 30<sup>th</sup> day of school. Anyone who is out of compliance will be excluded from school beginning October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Immunizations can be updated at your primary care doctor's office or by calling the Mecklenburg County Health Department at 704-336-6500. Health assessments are required for anyone entering a N.C. public school for the first time. They can be completed by your primary care doctor, CVS Minute Clinic, or an Urgent Care. If you have any ques-

tions please contact the school nurse at 980-343-6300.

Updated Covid Guidelines can be found on the CMS web page under the "parent portal". Students testing positive for Covid will be required to isolate at home for at least 5 days. They may return on day 6 if symptoms are improving, there has been no fever for 24 hours (without taking fever reducing medications), and agree to wear a mask for an additional 5 days.
