## **REPORT CARDS:**

Semester 1 report cards will be distributed tomorrow during a brief homeroom. Students who are absent will be able to pick up a copy of their report card from Student Services beginning next Monday.

Please Note – Some students enrolled in semester 1 English II will have not have a final grade for the course due to delayed EOC scores. Students can check PowerSchool for an updated grade. EOC scores are being entered over the next few "instructional days" and final grades are being calculated.

## **AP/IB/CCP INFORMATION NIGHT:**

AP/IB/CCP Information Night will be held on *Thursday, February 9, 2023, at 6:00 PM* for *rising* 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students. The night will begin in the Auditorium with a brief information session. Following the information session, families will have the opportunity to move throughout the campus and learn more about our AP, IB and CPCC course offerings. To help families plan for the evening, a document has been created that shows course offerings and where staff will be located following the initial information session (LINK). These courses are available to rising 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students.

Between *Friday, February 17 and Friday, March 3*, rising 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> grade students will have an opportunity to register for an individual meeting with their counselor using the counselor's <a href="BOOK AN APPOINTMENT">BOOK AN APPOINTMENT</a> link. During this time, students can make changes to their course requests based on information learned during AP/IB/CCP night.

If a rising 10<sup>th</sup> grader is interested in one of these courses for the 2023 – 2024 school year and did not register for the course during the registration process, then the student can email Allyson Davis, Assistant Principal of Instruction, and request the change.

Please Note – The order that students input requests into PowerSchool does not impact the probability of a student getting their primary course requests. Once all requests are entered into PowerSchool, then all students will be uploaded to courses via PowerSchool.

Students who are currently a junior and not scheduled for an English class on campus at Myers Park High School 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> semester are requested to schedule an appointment on *Tuesday, February 28*, with their counselor to complete their scheduling process.
