## **MIDTERMS BELL SCHEDULE:**

Students in 4X4 classes will be taking midterms next week. Midterms will be *Tuesday, March 21 thru Friday, March 24*. Midterms will be in this order - block 4, block 3, block 2, then block 1. We will follow a revised <u>bell schedule</u>. *Friday, March 24*, is the last day of quarter 3. *Monday, March 27*, is a teacher workday.

## HONORS LEADERSHIP & LEARNING (RISING GRADES 11 & 12):

For the 2023 – 2024 school year, Myers Park High School is launching Honors Leadership & Learning as a class that focuses on academic support via student-to-student peer tutoring. Honors Leadership & Learning will be a student led class that will offer tutoring in the following subjects: Math, English (Reading/Writing), Multilingual Learners (ML), and World Languages. If selected, a student will be enrolled in Honors Leadership & Learning for one block (A or B Day) and assigned to one or more classes to provide peer tutoring. The course will be weighted as a 0.5 course. Honors Leadership & Learning is ONLY open to students who are rising grade 11 and rising grade 12.

Students will complete a weekly reflection in response to the following core values of the class:

- 1. Students Tutored (Name, Grade, Start Time, End Time for Each)
- 2. Connections/Relationships (Means of Connecting with the Student(s))
- 3. Purpose in Tutoring (Class, Level, Topics Covered)
- 4. Process/Resources Used (Texts, Calculators, Chromebooks, Apps, Sites, etc....)
- 5. Outcomes (Successes, Areas of Growth Both for the Student Academically and the Tutor Personally)
- 6. Next Steps (if any)

Students will be graded based on the completed reflections each week and feedback from the teacher(s) in the assigned classes. Once the students are selected, then a leadership team will be established.
