## **HOMECOMING DANCE:**

Tomorrow, Saturday, October 15, 2022, is the MPHS Homecoming Dance from 8:00 PM to 11:00 PM.

To enter the dance, you must have **proof of purchase of the homecoming ticket AND a Photo ID.** The name on the Photo ID MUST match the name on the proof of purchase. To show proof of purchase, you can screenshot the confirmation OSP sent via email.

Forms of photo ID include:

- Driver's License
- Passport (or a picture of your passport)
- A screenshot of PowerSchool (if PowerSchool shows a photo of the student)
- A student ID from previous years that has the correct PHOTO AND NAME
- A picture from a Yearbook with the student's PHOTO AND NAME

Students may NOT transfer tickets to other students. If the name on the proof of purchase does not match the name on the photo ID, the student will not be admitted into the dance. A reimbursement form will be sent out next week for those students who could not make it to the dance. Students MUST arrive by 9:00 PM. Students will NOT be admitted into the dance after 9:00 PM.

## **PRE-ACT:**

The Pre-Act exam will be administered to 10<sup>th</sup> graders on *Wednesday, October 19, 2022*. All students will report to homeroom at 7:15 AM. Students who are not testing will have work to complete via Canvas for each of their classes. Attendance for the day will be taken in homeroom class.

To maintain a quiet testing environment and prevent test misadministration, NO students can be dismissed prior to the conclusion of testing at approximately 11:30 AM. Once testing concludes, then students will have an opportunity to eat lunch. Following lunch, students will return to homeroom and complete their work assigned in Canvas.

Parents/guardians are asked to complete <u>the Google Form</u> in advance if their student must be dismissed from school following testing on *Wednesday, October 19, 2022*. Only students with a completed <u>Google Form</u> in advance will be allowed to leave school *at the conclusion of testing that day (11:30 AM).* 

Students taking the Pre-ACT will need to *bring TWO number 2 pencils and a calculator*. Technology and devices of any kind are strictly prohibited during testing. Devices brought to school must be powered off and collected during the Pre-ACT administration. Students who violate prohibited technology policy will be removed from the testing room immediately.
