


## School Board Member District 4 & 5

The Cotswold Elementary School project is an onsite replacement, while the Billingsville Elementary School project is a renovation to support a program relocation and expansion. This project involves the onsite replacement of Cotswold Elementary School; the repurposing of Billingsville Elementary School to accommodate the relocated Montessori PK-6 program; and the demolition of Chantilly Elementary School. The new Cotswold Elementary will be the single site for the K-5 populations currently served at Billingsville and Cotswold. The paired schools will relocate to Billingsville for the duration of the construction of the new Cotswold.
