I. Call to order with Mission Statement

III. Approval of September 13, 2024 Minutes - Ritzer motioned, Vourlas-Davis seconded, all in favor

IV. Principal Report - Becky Crawford -

General Update: impressed with teacher response during hurricane; SPARK is today (rescheduled from hurricane); working to get play up and running; student government is coming out this week; will have Kids' voting day; yearbook getting up and run

a.) Comprehensive Plan - meeting on Nov 7 at 6:30; should be looking at drawings of new building; we have requested a field to be put in at the campus; supposed to be torn down in September; currently still up, possibly due to hurricane

b.) Curriculum Night - last night 10/11/24; teacher's prepared and presented slideshows with expectations, procedures, curriculum, etc. Ms. Person and Ms. Rivera added that it is so nice to be back in person and for parents to see the classrooms. The turnout was okay. Parent feedback was shared - the timing of the event without having children allowed made it trickier; Rescheduled event also may have affected the turnout; it's a hard balance to make sure teachers aren't working too long and also accommodating parent's schedules; teachers have childcare issues as well

c.) Title IX - No new incidents; all teachers have completed Title IX lessons with their classes (except Kinder because those lessons have not been released yet); we continue to talk with students about appropriate and respectful behavior

V. Parent Business - Becky explained the FAC, STAC, etc. process of how concerns are elevated to the superintendent. Dr. Hill is adding a parent component to this process (thanks to a recommendation by Nicole!!). Becky explained the new iReady program being used for assessment and personalized learning paths - this replaced MAP. It also allows teachers to assign specific lessons based on student needs. Teachers are implementing a time to

confer with their students on the lessons. It's about 20 minutes a day in both reading and math. This is replacing Dreambox in math. Dreambox will only be used for interventions. Sarah shared that the parent report is much clearer and easier to understand.

VI. PTA Update - Nicole Vourlas-Davis PTA President

K Parent Social - @ Hop Fly - about 70 rsvp, - was rescheduled due to the hurricane, around 40 showed up. Suggestion to do K Parent Social twice a year, once in Fall and once in Spring

Spark - latest numbers are at \$53,000 - technically met goal at \$50,000, but are hoping to receive more - will continue to remain open.

Service Learning this year will focus on supporting the families and areas affected by the hurricane. This will be a long-term project across all grade-levels. (Blurb coming out in Dragon Dispatch)
