



Voter FAQs

On Nov. 7, Mecklenburg County voters will have an important decision to make regarding a \$2.5 billion bond renewal for Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools. The 30 high-priority projects aimed at providing significant benefits for students and schools. These projects will offer more academic options, alleviate overcrowding, and renovations and replacements of aging CMS facilities.



When is the vote?

The general election is Nov. 7, 2023.



When is the deadline to register to vote?

The deadline to register for the general election is Oct. 11, 2023.



Can I vote early?

Yes. Early voting starts Oct. 19 and ends on Nov. 4.



How can I register to vote?

To register, you can pick up a registration form at any Charlotte-Mecklenburg public library or at the Board of Elections office located at 741 Kenilworth Ave., Suite 202.

You can also visit the Board of Elections website at www.meckboe.org to download the registration application. If you have any questions, feel free to call the Board of Elections at 704-336-2133. Remember, you must be a U.S. citizen, a resident of North Carolina and Mecklenburg County for 30 days, and at least 18 years old to register.
