4. CMS Benchmark Assessments – We will be giving CMS Quarterly Benchmark Assessments in Math and ELA next week on Monday and Tuesday. The assessment encompasses everything they have learned thus far in first quarter and will count as a prepare grade so students should be encouraged to do their best.

5. Suicide Prevention Lessons in 6th & 7th Grade - For the 2023 - 2024 school year, the district has requested all Middle Schools to continue with the Suicide Pilot Prevention presentation to be conducted by the Counseling Department in the classrooms. The initial presentation was provided last school year to the 6th graders. For the current school year, the current 6th graders will receive the full presentation and the current

7th graders will receive a refresher lesson. The School Counselors will be available following their presentation to address any student questions or concerns. Parent letters regarding the pilot program have already been sent home with 7th grade students since we began the lessons this past week. Letters will be sent home to 6th grade parents in the next few days with their lessons starting soon.
