Grading Expectations for a 50% - We have seen a dramatic 4. increase with students expecting to get the minimum 50% grade when they turn in an assignment that is only partially completed or completed with no effort. Students are trying to be savvy by turning in incomplete assignments expecting a 50% if they know that a prepare or rehearse grade of a 50% will not drastically change their overall grade. Moving forward, students will be expected to put forth their best effort to meet the expectations of every assignment or they will receive the actual score that resulted in the work turned in. For example, if they complete 2 out of 10 questions or show no work on your math assignment, a 20% grade and the incomplete assignment box will be permanently marked in the grade book. We ask that parents reinforce the fact that homework, projects, and other assignments are important and will have a negative impact on their grades if not completed according to the expectations for the assignment.


