What is a Title I school?

Title I is the largest federally funded educational program. A Title I school is a school receiving federal funds for students. The basic principle of Title I is that schools with large concentrations of low-income students receive supplemental funds to meet students' educational goals.

What does it mean to be a Title I School?

- Being a Title I school means receiving federal funding (Title I dollars) to <u>supplement</u> the school's existing programs. These dollars are used for the following:
 - Purchasing resources and materials to help meet the state's challenging content standards.
 - Purchasing supplemental staff and programs
 - Conducting parent and family engagement meetings and opportunities
 - Recruiting/Hiring/Retaining Highly-Qualified Teachers
- Being a Title I school also means encouraging ongoing parent and family engagement

How are Title I funds used in our school for 2023-2024 school year?

- Teacher
- Teacher Assistant
- Professional Development for staff
- Substitutes for staff professional development
- Instructional Materials
- Technology
- Supplies and materials (books, classroom supplies, etc.)
- Parent Engagement/Involvement
 - Schools must set-aside money for parent involvement/engagement-Our amount is \$4671.24

What is the CMS and School's Parent and Family Engagement Policy?

- These policies address how the school and district will implement the parent and family engagement requirements
 - The school and district's expectations for parents
 - How CMS/ schools will engage parents in decision-making
 - How the district will work increase family engagement activities to improve student academic achievement
- These policies are revisited each year by the School Improvement Team (SIT)

Title I Parents also need to know...

- Read, review with your child the School Compact (send back signed)
- Parent have the "Right to Know" about their child's teacher
- Join Parent Square-Read all parent communication on Parent Square i.e. Monthly Newsletters, PTA information, etc

How will I be notified if my child is taught by a teacher who is not Highly-Qualified?

- Being Highly Qualified in NC means you have successfully passed the licensure exams required or received alternate licensure in a way set out by NC law.
- Parents and families are notified each quarter if teachers have not met requirements for Highly-Qualified
- Parents may request information on teacher qualifications in writing to Ms. Young

MAP (Measures of Academic Progress)	Administered BOY, MOY and EOY Literacy-2nd BOY only —4th and 5th-BOY, MOY and EOY Math-1st-5th BOY, MOY and EOY K starts MATH MAP (MOY and EOY)
DIBELs	Administered 3 times a year-BOY, MOY and EOY (Grades K-3)
Classroom Assessments	Administered at the end of each topic or unit and student checks (CFUs) are given as content is taught (Grades K-5)
EOG- (End-of-Grade)	Administered in May for grades 3-5 Math and Literacy (Science-5th only)
BOG (Beginning of Grade)	Literacy-3rd only (September 12, 2023)




