# Hello South Charlotte Middle School Families!

The South Charlotte team is eagerly preparing to welcome our students and families back to school! We are looking forward to a school year with many of our familiar routines and traditions back on the calendar. I am sure you have many questions about the upcoming school year. Families can expect to receive information frequently to keep you informed. We will also continue to provide information on the website.

CMS continues to partner with the Mecklenburg County Health Department and NCDHHS to implement strategies to reduce the risk of the transmission of COVID-19 at schools. Many of the COVID protocols and restrictions have been removed, or revised, from the guidance provided in the Strong Schools NC Public Health Toolkit. This will mean a much more typical school experience for students, staff, and families.

Face coverings will be required for all staff, students, and visitors while indoors on all CMS school campuses and school buses. Additionally, frequent hand washing/sanitizing and distancing (at least three feet) will be in place during breakfast and lunch when masks can't be worn. I know that we are all eager to be done with face masks, but we're not there just yet. Our most important priority is to protect our students from illness and have them at school!

#### With the above measures in place, we will NO longer be required to:

- Maintain physical distancing in the classrooms
  - · Limit sharing of materials and equipment
    - · Plan for periods of remote learning
- Refrain from allowing visitors and volunteers for events and school activities (face masks must be worn)
  - Direct quarantines for close contacts of positive cases identified at school (when universal masking has been implemented)

We look forward to resuming clubs and athletics, and welcoming families and volunteers back on campus. Information about athletics went out by way of the Connect Ed message and is posted on our website. If you are not a registered CMS volunteer, please do so as soon as possible.

#### From the PE Department:

Clothes for PE: Students should wear clothes that are appropriate of movement in Physical Education Class and follow the school dress code. Examples of clothes that would be appropriate for class are:

- Shorts- (must stay up on the hips and follow dress code length)
- T-shirts- long or short sleeve- (Must be a CREW NECK- may NOT be v-neck, boat-neck, any low cut neck shirt or tank top)
- Sweatshirts- can be worn for outdoor units but will not be worn indoors for class
- Sweatpants- must stay up on the hips and not sag
- Yoga pants with shorts over them- shorts have to be worn over the top of yoga pants
- Running shoes or sneakers ONLY- shoe strings MUST be tied- NO EXCEPTIONS
- CLEAR small water bottle- Water bottle has to be see-through but may be a colored plastic as long as we can see contents through the bottle.

Returning users must update their account.

- 1. Log in to www.Pay4SchoolStuff.com using your User ID and Password.
- 2. On the Welcome Screen, click Edit to update the Grade and Homeroom Teacher for your returning student(s). You can also add new student(s) in the Add a Student to Your Account section. Complete all fields and click Submit.
