Since 1923, the **Alliance for Young Artists and Writers** presents the **Scholastic Art and Writing Awards** each year to teens who demonstrate exceptional artistic and literary talent. It is our country's most prestigious award for teen artists. Past recipients of the award include Robert Redford, Ken Burns, John Lithgow, Truman Capote, Sylvia Plath, John Updike and Andy Warhol. Last week, from the thousands of submissions from our Mid-Carolinas 18-county region, Eighth grader Nadia Lundell won a Gold Key award for her painting "Mother Nature's Mirror."

Submissions from middle schools were included with high school submissions and local luminaries blind judged all works. Nadia also won Honorable Mention for her painting "Reflections Between Us." An award ceremony was held virtually at https://youtu.be/O_gmRbV6t0o this past Saturday, and Gold Key works of art will be exhibited at the Mint Museum Uptown from March 17 to April 23.

- ◆ Online School Payments (OSP) - CMS has provided us with the opportunity to accept payments for school events on-line.
