CMS SOUTH COUNTY RELIEF SCHOOL UPDATES: DRAFT 2

CMS is building a new high school as well as proposing a new middle school, in order to relieve overcrowding at middle and high schools in the South County region of CMS. These new schools will impact boundaries for many elementary, middle, and high schools in our area. The CMS Planning Department is working closely with CMS leaders and community workgroups to develop scenarios to share with the impacted communities.

CMS has just released a DRAFT 2 scenario, based on feedback received from Draft 1. This new scenario emphasizes SES diversity as well as staff utilization and building capacities.

A public hearing and final draft will be presented to the Charlotte Mecklenburg Board of Education on **May 23**, and the CMBE vote will be held on **June 6**.
