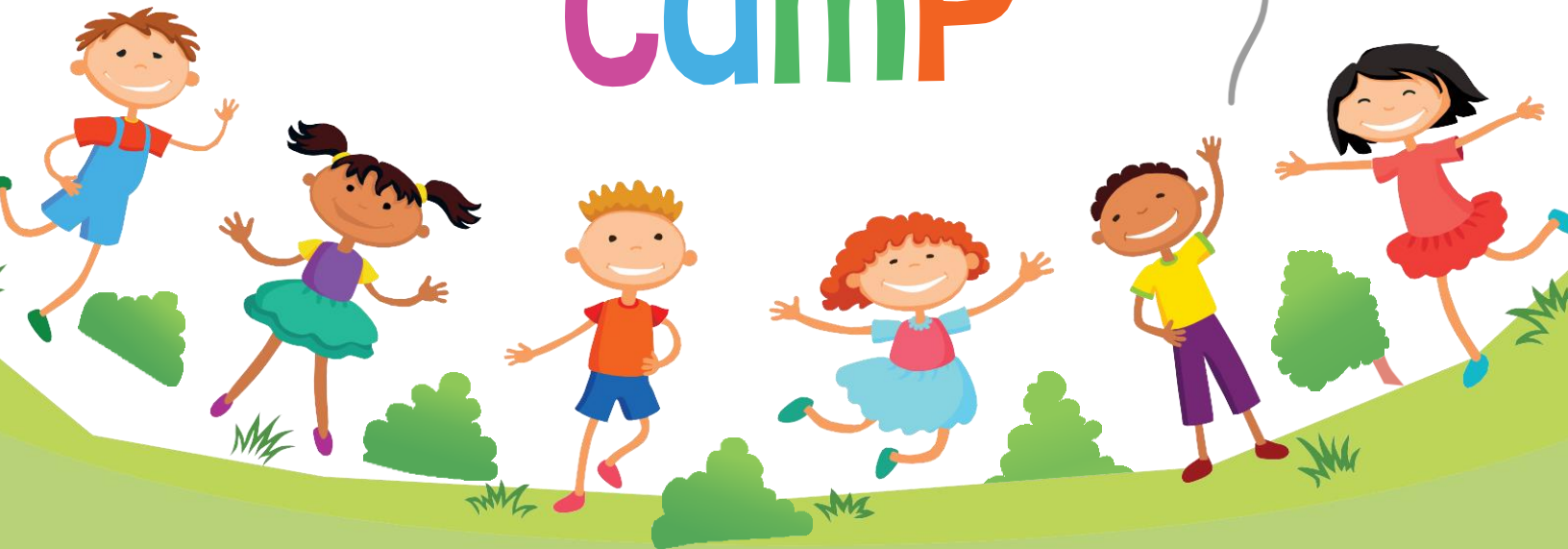

Traditional Camps

WEEKLY THEMES:

Celebrating Diversity: Campers will be welcomed to the world of multicultural art! Campers will understand and appreciate another culture by researching the people, food, music, and language through creating arts and crafts.

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2024 SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

Full Day

Operating Hours:

6:45 AM – 6:00 PM

(AM & PM snacks provided)

A nutritious bag lunch is required each day of care.

Total Cost: \$150.00 per week

Weekly Deposit: \$75.00 per child

All summer camps are licensed by the North Carolina Division of Child Development and can receive families with subsidies through Child Care Resources, Inc. (CCRI). Staff to student ratios are 1:19 or 2:25.

- Families are responsible for transportation to and from the camp.
- ASEP Summer Camp is open for current CMS students only. Students who have completed Kindergarten through age 12 are eligible to attend.
- **Summer Camps are closed on Thursday, July 4th. Fees are not prorated during this week.**

HOW TO ENROLL:

The following requirements are needed to complete enrollment in the ASEP Summer Camp:

1. For **current ASEP students and families** use the link <https://cmsk12.reg.eleyo.com/> for Non-School Day Care (Summer Camp). Enroll for all weeks, some weeks, or some weeks at one site and some at another. The cost is \$150.00 per week, per student attending ASEP summer camps. Please refer to the ASEP Summer Camp Payment Guidelines for payment requirements.
2. For **new families** needing Non-School Day Care (Summer Camp). Follow the instructions below.
 - From the ASEP Eleyo website, <https://cmsk12.reg.eleyo.com/> click “Register Here.”
 - Select from the locations, “Summer Camp Only.”
 - Follow the instructions to create an Eleyo account to successfully create a “Registration Contract” for Summer Camp Only.
 - After successful completion of a “Registration Contract for Summer Camp Only. You will then select your camp choice (s), a \$75 per week (**non-refundable/non-transferable**) deposit for summer camp will reserve a space for your child. The remaining balance will be due each Monday prior to the week your child attends. (Refer to the ASEP Summer Camp Payment Guidelines) your child attends.
 - A \$47 per family registration fee is required only if children are **not** currently enrolled in the ASEP.
 - Upon receipt of a CCRI family contract, the ASEP will obtain a voucher directly from CCRI through the NC Fast system. ***CCRI, McKinney Vento (MCV) and DSS families must complete a Summer Camp contract by June 7, 2024, to have vouchers in place for service.**
 - Families with CCRI co-payments will be responsible for making weekly fee payments through Eleyo.
 - No additional activity fees will be charged.
 - **Summer Camp Confirmations will be emailed to families from Eleyo upon registration approval.**
 - **Fees are non-refundable/non-transferable**

ASEP 2024 Summer Camp Payment Guidelines

ASEP Summer Camps require a \$75 deposit for each week of camp per child registered due at the time of registration.

The remaining full cost of camp \$75 per week for each child registered is due the Monday prior to the week of camp your child will be attending Summer Camps. Failure to pay the remaining balance will result in forfeiture of your child's spot for Summer Camp. **NO Exceptions.**

ASEP Summer Camp fees and deposits are Non-Transferable/Refundable. Fees cannot be applied to other weeks or Fall 2024.

- CCRI Subsidy co-payments are due on a ***weekly basis, not monthly, unless paid in advance.***
- A \$47 family registration fee is required only for children **not currently** enrolled in the After School Enrichment Program and is **non-refundable and non-transferable.** This fee is required at the time of registration contract approval.
- Payment for the full week is required even if a child participates for only a part of the week.
