End Of Grade Testing Info:

End of year testing continues next week. Please see below for next week's schedule. We appreciate the many volunteers who have signed up to help with testing. We couldn't do it without you. There are more volunteer opportunities available next week. Please sign-up using Sign up genius link below.

We want our students to do their best on testing days. Here is some important information for a successful testing experience:

- Please be sure students are well rested on testing days by allowing at least 8 hours of sleep (according to the CDC).
- Please be sure students eat a healthy breakfast. Remember that free breakfast is provided at school each day.
- Please be sure students arrive to school by 8:20 am so testing can begin on time.
- The end of year testing is about students showing what they know and can do. We know students are prepared and will do their best. They do not need to be stressed about testing.
- Cell phones and smart devices: Students may not have cell phones, Smartwatches, smart devices, fitbits or any type of tracker during testing. We advise students to leave these devices at home on testing days.
 - On testing days, students should only bring with them to school:
 - o pencil,
 - o novel to read after testing
 - lunch (unless purchasing lunch)
 - o and instrument, if student has orchestra or band class that day


